## : NOTIFICATION :

### Sub: Eligibility Criteria for Admission to 1<sup>st</sup> Sem B.E. /B.Tech. / B.Arch. Courses

With reference to the above, it is hereby notified to all the Principals of Engineering Colleges affiliated to/ Autonomous under VTU that the guidelines specified below shall be followed for admitting candidates to I year B.E. / B.Tech. / B.Arch. courses.

#### Academic Eligibility :

a) **For admission to B.E./B.Tech. Courses:** The student should have passed 2<sup>nd</sup> PUC / 12<sup>th</sup> standard or equivalent examination with English as one of the languages and obtained 45% of marks in aggregate in Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with one of the Chemistry / Bio-Technology / Computer Science / Electronics / Biology. In case of candidates belonging to Karnataka Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe and other Backward Classes (Category I, 2A,2B, 3A and 3B), the minimum marks for the purpose of eligibility will be 40% of marks in aggregate in the optional subjects in the qualifying examination.

b) **For Admission to B.Arch.:** The student should have passed 2<sup>nd</sup> PUC /12<sup>th</sup> standard or equivalent examination with Mathematics as a compulsory optional subject and obtained a minimum of 50% of marks in aggregate in all the subjects in qualifying examination [45% of marks in case a candidates belonging to Karnataka Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe and other Backward Classes (Category I, 2A,2B, 3A and 3B)] and should compulsorily appear for NATA [National Aptitude Test in Architecture] and get a minimum of 40% in it (including SC, ST and other Backward Classes)

In case of any doubt or ambiguity, the Principals are requested to refer the individual case to the University for Clarification. It is also brought to the notice of the Principals that in case of improper admission, the Principal is wholly responsible and provisional admission made shall be withdrawn by the University. Therefore, the Principals are advised to take utmost care while admitting candidates to the respective courses, so as to avoid cancellation of admission and litigation later on.

The Principals of Engineering colleges are requested to bring the contents of this notification to all the concerned, and also display it prominently on the notice board/ college official website.
