CIRCULAR

Subject: 2021 and 2022 scheme NSS/Yoga/Sports etc regarding...

Reference:

1. Sport Subcommittee proceeding dated 26th and 27th August 2024

In the 2021 scheme, Sports/NSS/Yoga activities are conducted from the 3rd to the 8th semester. Students must complete the selected activities within this duration and appear for the Semester End Examination (SEE) in the 8th semester. The final qualification is determined by the combined Continuous Internal Evaluation (CIE) marks and SEE marks in the 8th semester. To qualify, a student must secure a minimum of 40% of the maximum CIE marks, at least 35% of the maximum SEE marks, and a combined total of at least 40% from both CIE and SEE marks.

As per the proceedings of the 179th EC meeting, colleges must arrange for the conduction of the Semester End Examination (SEE) before the last working day of the 8th semester.

The details regarding the conduction of the SEE are outlined below:

The conduction of the SEE (Semester End Examination) for Sports /NSS/Yoga under the 2021 scheme includes:

1. Examination Conduction:

The Semester End Examination (SEE) or Continuous Internal Evaluation (CIE) shall be conducted by the faculty in charge of Sports/NSS/Yoga or the designated faculty coordinator from the respective department. This faculty member shall be appointed by the principal of the college, with due information provided to the Registrar (Evaluation).

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2. Examination Format:

The examination shall be conducted as a theory paper with a duration of 1 hour.

The question paper shall consist of 50 Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) and shall be prepared exclusively by the faculty in charge or the designated faculty coordinator.

3. Evaluation and Marks Submission:

After the examination, the concerned faculty shall complete the evaluation.

The Registrar (Evaluation) will issue a circular to notify when the marks need to be uploaded.

4. Timing of the Examination:

The SEE must be completed before the last working day of the semester.

The methods should ensure a standardized approach to evaluating students' understanding and participation in Sports/NSS/Yoga activities as per the 2021 scheme.

The conduction of the CIE (Semester End Examination) for Sports /NSS/Yoga under the 2022 scheme includes:

1. CIE should be conducted as mentioned in the scheme and syllabus
2. The candidate has to secure minimum of 40% of maximum marks of CIE to qualify in this course.
3. The candidate may continue the same chosen course (NSS/Sports/Yoga) between 3rd to 6th semester. However the option is given to students to change the activity. He /she may opt for the change of the course in ensuing semester. If the student is opting new course in 5th semester first time, he/she may take the basic modules(lower semester) from the syllabus to complete and if they repeat the same course in ensuing semester, subsequent modules can be offered.

The principals of all engineering colleges affiliated with the university are requested to communicate the contents of these circular to all relevant stakeholders.
