BOS meeting in Electrical & Electronics Engineering was held on 03rd October 2015 at 11.00 AM in the VTU's Regional Office, Bangalore.

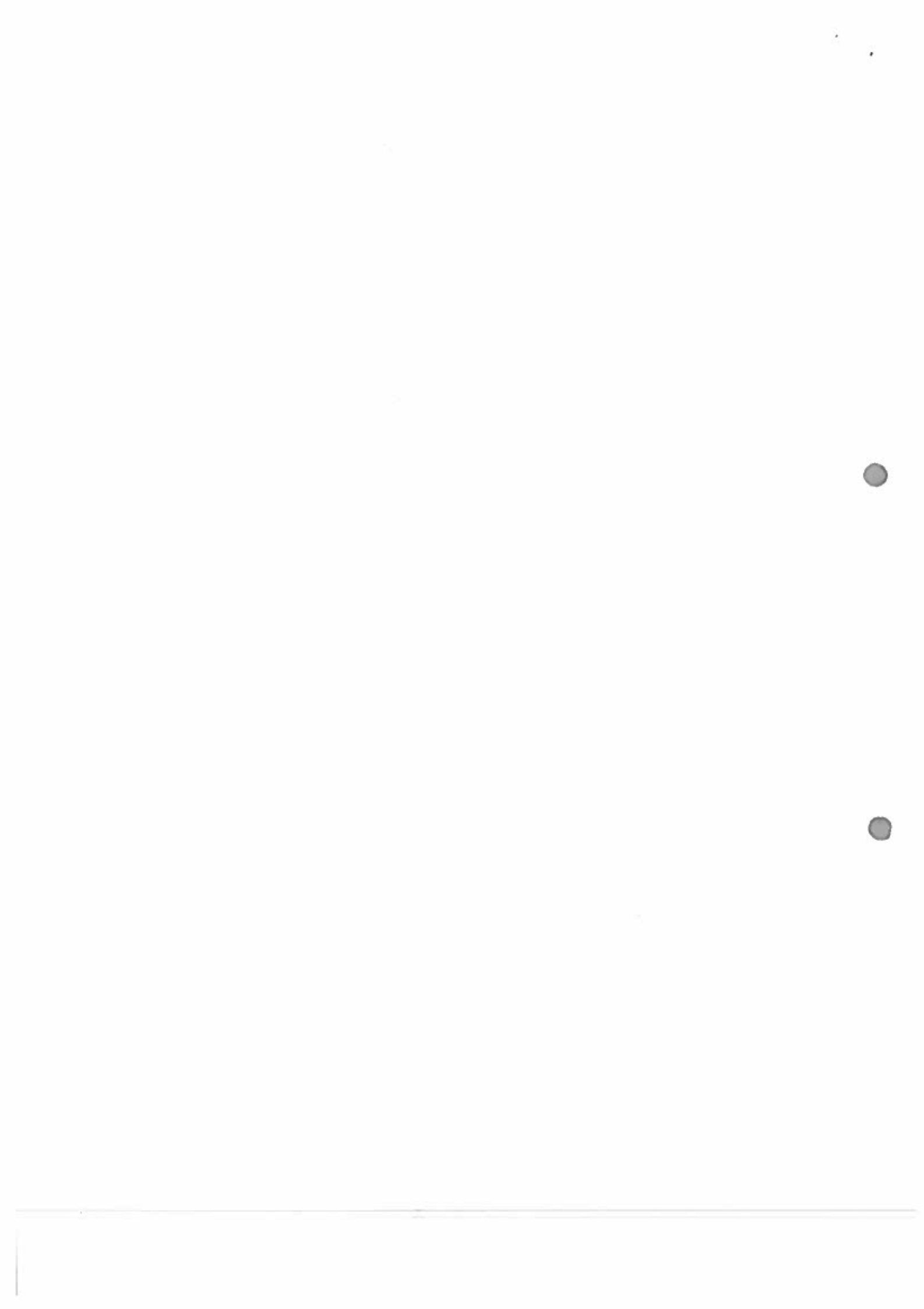
The Chairman, BOS in Electrical & Electronics Engineering welcomed the members of BOS, and Special Invitees.

Resolutions:

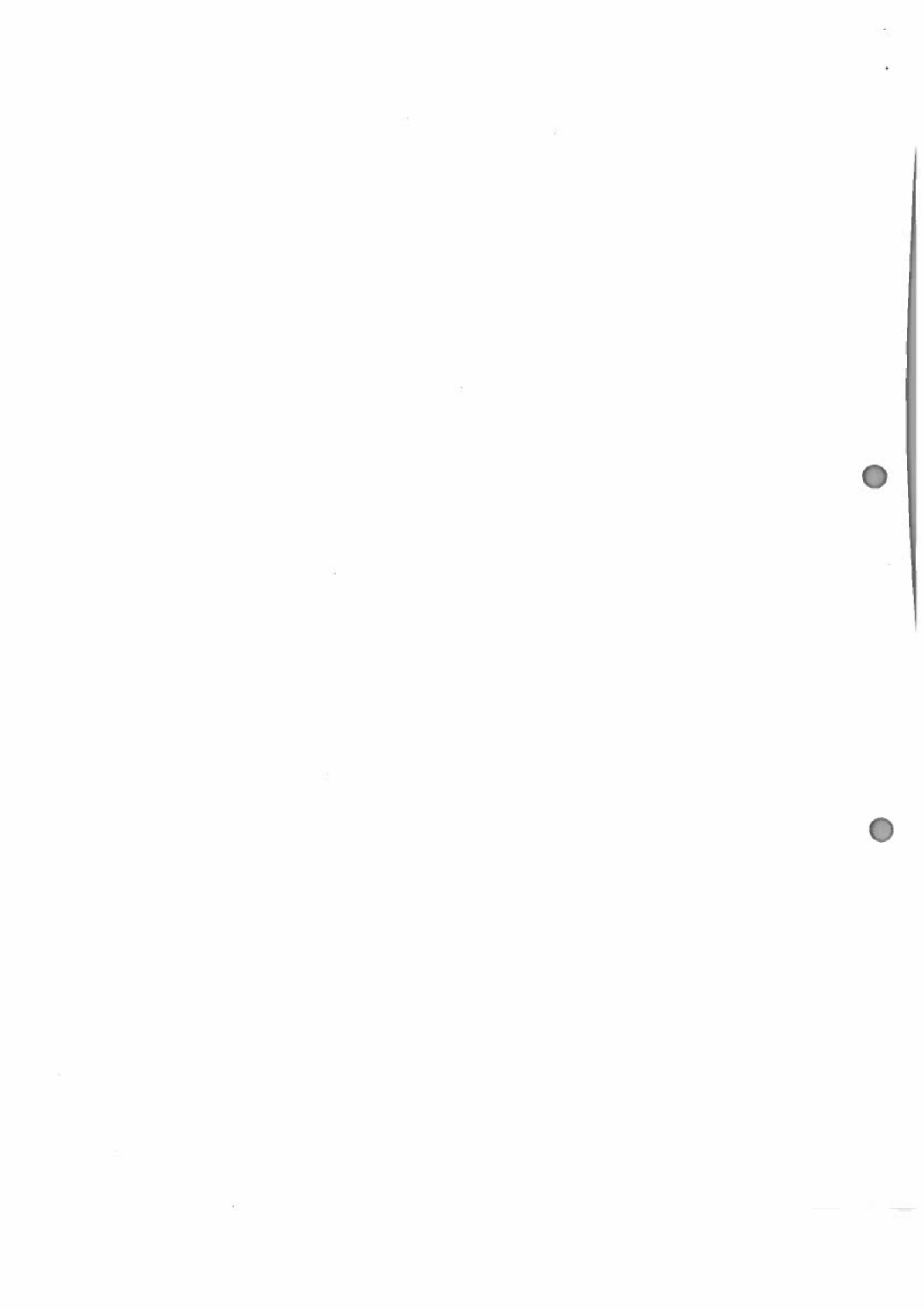
1. The proceedings of the previous meeting held on 21-06-2014 were read and confirmed.

3. The Member were of the opinion that the following typographical errors be brought to the notice of The Registrar, VTU. For details Please refer to the Annexure – I and II.

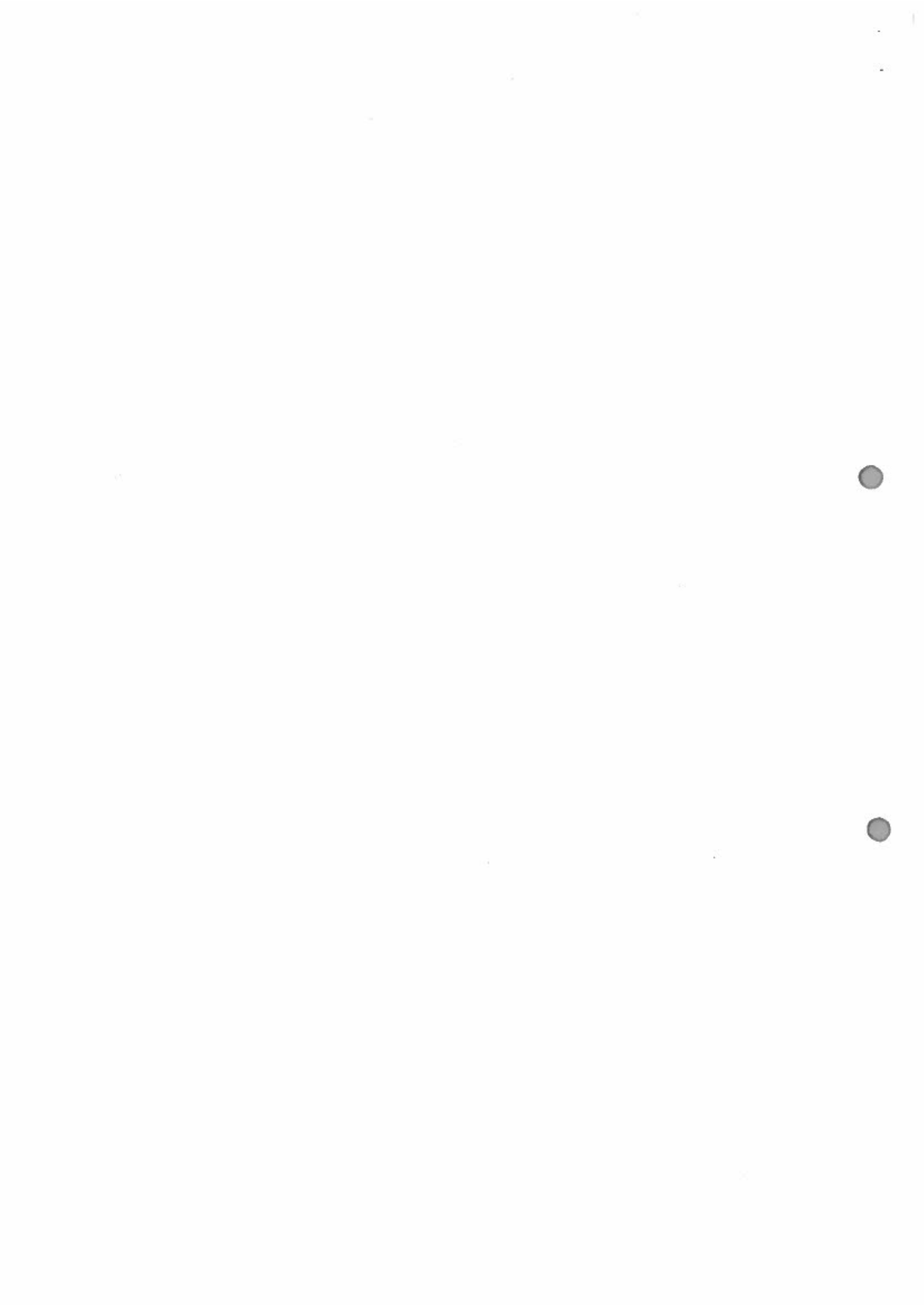
