The curriculum for postgraduate (PG) programs is updated every two years, while undergraduate (UG) programs are revised every four years. In accordance with the BoS and JBOS proceedings referenced in (1), (2), and (3), and following the guidelines of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, the 2024 scheme for M.Tech. programs has been meticulously developed to match the high standards of premier institutions like NITs, IITs, and IISc. As a result, the first-semester courses for all M.Tech. programs have been standardized across allied streams, with stream-specific courses introduced starting from the second semester.

This new scheme has been crafted to align with industry trends, promote skill development, and address evolving academic standards. Provisions have been incorporated into the M.Tech. scheme to benefit students effectively.

- Students pursuing a two-semester Industry/Research Internship culminating in project work or a startup.
- Students opting for a one-semester Industry/Research Internship.
- Students engaging in research work aimed at publishing papers in Q1/Q2/Q3 journals, potentially leading to registration in a Ph.D. program.

Similarly, for MCA, MBA, M.Arch, and M.Plan programs, student-centric provisions have been introduced, allowing them to choose elective courses and opt for internship opportunities tailored to their academic and career goals.

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Based on the feedback (6) received from students and teachers, the scheme and syllabus have been revised by the respective Board of Studies and uploaded on the VTU web portal at <https://vtu.ac.in/en/pg-scheme-syllabus/> for reference and use.

The principals of all engineering colleges affiliated with the university are requested to communicate the contents of this circular to all relevant stakeholders.
