2.1: Affiliation Matters

Item No.2.1.1 of the Agenda of 161st meeting of the Executive Council to be held on 14th September 2021

CONSIDERATION OF THE EXPERT COMMITTEE REPORT ON FEASIBILITY TO START INSTITUTE OF MARINE ENGINEERING AT BELTHANGADY TALUK, DAKSHINA KANNADA DIST.

A proposal for setting up Marine Engineering related Institute at Belthangady, was received at VTU from Shri Harish Poonja, Hon'ble Member of Legislative Assembly of Belthangady Constituency, Dakshina Kannada District.

Based on this proposal, an Expert Committee was constituted to study and report about the feasibility of starting Institute / Centre of Marine Engineering at Belthangady.

The Committee conducted its meeting twice through digital mode, keeping in view the prevailing COVID 19 Pandemic and also visited once the proposed site physically.

After detailed deliberations on the proposal, the Committee has submitted a report recommending that starting of 4 year B.E. programme in Marine Engineering is not feasible. Instead skill development courses related to Marine and allied courses may be started in the said area.

The subject along with the Expert Committee report in this regard is placed before the Executive Council for consideration and approval.

The subject has been placed before the Academic Senate and the Academic Senate has recommended to accept the Expert Committee report.

Resolution No.2.1.1

The Executive Council resolved to accept the recommendations of Academic Senate which recommended to accept the Report submitted by the Expert Committee which has recommended that starting 4 year B.E. programme in Marine Engineering at Belthangady Taluk, Dakshina Kannada Dist., is not feasible, instead skill development courses related to Marine and allied courses may be started in the said place. Further, the Executive Council resolved to accept the recommendation of the Academic Senate which recommended to request for the free land required and financial assistance to develop infrastructure (civil constructions), from the State Government for setting up the said Skill Centre and VTU to take care of the Lab Equipments, Computing facilities, furniture and human resources for conducting the said Skill programmes.

Further, the Executive Council suggested to start the Marine related Skill Development courses at VTU NASD, Dandeli, as there is good scope for Skill Development in this area comprising of Ship Building, Hydraulics etc.. Subsequently these courses may be shifted to Belthangady Skill Development Centre.

The Executive Council further suggested to see the feasibility of starting Marine related UG/PG programmes with Karwar Naval Base utilising the infrastructure available at Karwar naval base, in Air Force Technical Centre(AFTC) model.

The Principal, Dr. M. S. Sheshgiri College of Engineering & Technology, Belagavi, vide letter Ref.No.KLEMSSCET/Affli/21-22/254, dt:04-08-2021, has requested VTU, for the progressive closure of the programmes offered under VTU at this College from the academic year 2021-22.

The Board of Management of KLE Society has passed a Resolution to consider the said College as the Constituent College of KLE Technological University, Hubballi.

The State Government has granted its approval for the same, subject to the condition of consequent approval by the Karnataka Higher Education Council, UGC/AICTE and concerned National Accreditation Bodies.

The subject, along with related documents is placed before the Executive Council for consideration and approval.

The subject has been placed before the Academic Senate and the Academic Senate has recommended for the progressive closure of the Programmes at the said College following the VTU norms.

Resolution No.2.1.2

The President, SDM Jain Math Trust, Varur Hubli, has requested for the complete closure of its college JAGM Institute of Technology, Jamkhandi, from the academic year 2021-22.

The college had applied for the progressive closure in the affiliation application for the academic year 2021-22 and the same has been recommended by VTU LIC and LIC RRC.

Now, the Trust running the said college is requesting for the transfer of students studying in the college to other college and for complete closure of the college due to very poor strength of students.

The subject, along with a letter from the President of the Trust, is placed before the Executive Council for consideration and further approval.

The subject has been placed before the Academic Senate and the Academic Senate has recommended for the complete closure of the said College following the VTU norms.

The subject has been placed before the Academic Senate and the Academic Senate has recommended to accept the recommendations of the Standing Committee.

COLLECTION OF FIXED DEPOSIT FROM GOVERNMENT ENGINEERING / ARCHITECTURE COLLEGES

As per the decision of the Executive Council in the meeting held on 28-06-2017, Res.No.2.1.7, the new Engineering/ Architecture Colleges need to submit joint Fixed Deposit of Rs. 25 lakhs, before issuing Affiliation Notification w.e.f. the academic year 2017-18. The amount is refundable after the completion of 10 years with interest amount. The amount may be forfeited if the colleges gets disaffiliated before the completion of 10 years.

Now, the subject is placed before the Executive Council, to direct the applicability of this resolution to Government Engineering / Architecture Colleges.

Resolution No.2.1.5

The Executive Council resolved to wave off the submission of Fixed Deposit for the Government Engineering / Government Architecture Colleges under VTU.

Further, for other than Government Engineering Colleges, the Executive Council resolved to collect Rs. 25 lakhs Fixed Deposit, as resolved earlier, and to refund the same after completion of 10 years along with the interest.

Further, the Executive Council resolved that after completing 10 years of existence, the concerned college shall produce Bank Guarantee of Rs.25 lakhs for the period of further 10 years.

APPROVAL FOR ADMISSION PROCESS FOR MBA PROGRAMME IN INNOVATION, ENTREPRENRENEUR-SHIP AND VENTURE DEVELOPMENT(IEV)

The VTU NISP Committee had recommended to start MBA in Innovation Entrepreneurship and Venture Development (IVE) at VTU. The Scheme of Teaching and Examination and syllabus outlines of the said programme have been prepared as per the AICTE Start-up Policy Implementation Cell and MHRD guidelines and the same is approved by VTU Joint board of Studies and subsequently by the Executive Council in its 156th meeting held on 16-3-2021. This programme will be offered by VTU NISP Cell as an autonomous programme of VTU.

The admission eligibility, fee structure, intake and admission process of the said MBA (IEV) programme have been discussed by the VTU NISP Committee and the Committee has recommended for admission to the said programme with an intake of 30 seats for the academic year 2021-22.

The admission process shall be conducted by VTU, and it shall be, in general, as per the norms of KEA. The Merit list for admission shall be prepared by the University on the basis of combined scores of the following component with weightages as below:

- 1. Graduation marks 40%
- 2. Case Study 20%
- 3. Personal interview 30% and
- 4. Work experience 10%

In case of tie in final score, the following method of tie-breaker shall be used:

The total aggregate marks in the qualifying examination of the candidate shall be marked. The higher qualifying marks shall gain higher merit. If the marks scored in the qualifying examination are equal again, then the age of the candidate shall be taken into account, and the candidate elder in age will get higher merit.

The subject is placed before the Executive Council for consideration and approval for the proposed admission process as referred above.

The subject has been placed before the Academic Senate and the Academic Senate has recommended to accept the proposed admission process.
