**100<sup>th</sup> E.C. Meeting (7<sup>th</sup> April 2012)**

**Award of degrees to the list of eligible candidates**

It was a pre-convocation meeting and the Executive Council resolved to approve the list of eligible candidates for award of various degrees of VTU for the academic year 2011-12.

**Development work of VTU Institute of Advanced Technology Campus**

Executive Council granted approval for the construction of PG Blocks, Hostel and Dining Buildings, under the work of development of VTU Institute of Advanced Technology at Muddenahalli, Chikkaballapur District.

**Granting recognition of Research Centres to the Departments of affiliated colleges**

Executive Council accorded approval for the grant of recognition to 95 department of the affiliated engineering colleges as fresh Research Centres of VTU.

**Construction of buildings for the Govt. Engineering Colleges**

Executive Council approved the recommendations of the Estate Board to take up the construction of buildings for the four Govt. Engineering Colleges, located at Raichur, Hoovinahadagali, Karwar and Gangavathi, which are handed over to VTU by the Government.
