International Women's Day 2022

Women's Day is celebrated every year around the world on March 8. This year, it falls on a Tuesday. As the name suggests, it is a day dedicated to women, a symbolic reminder of the historic journey they have taken globally to better their lives, and that while a lot has been achieved on that front, the journey is still long and more needs to be done.

As the world celebrates women, we take a look at the global day that has shaped society by highlighting issues that have affected women for many years.

Women in different parts of the world use this day to come together to celebrate one another and rally for equal treatment and representation

Theme

The theme for International Women's Day, 2022 (IWD 2022) is 'Gender equality today for a sustainable tomorrow'. It attempts to recognize the "contribution of women and girls around the world, who are leading the charge on climate change adaptation, mitigation, and response, to build a more sustainable future for all".

Additionally, international womens day states that IWD 2022 campaign theme is '**#BreakTheBias**'. It intends to promote a "**gender equal world**", which is "free of bias, stereotypes, and discrimination". "A world that is diverse, equitable, and inclusive" and where "difference is valued and celebrated".

We have today the opportunity to put women and girls at the centre of our planning and action and to integrate gender perspectives into global and national laws and policies.

Significance of International Women's Day

IWD has been celebrated for over a century now, but many people think of it purely as a feminist cause. Its roots, however, are found in the labour movement, wherein it was first organized in 1911 by the early 20th century Marxist from Germany Clara Zetkin.

Zetkin was born in 1857 in Wiederau, where she trained as a teacher, and was associated with the Social Democratic Party (SPD) — one of the two major political parties in Germany. She participated in both labour movement and women's movement.

The most consequential International Women's Day protest took place in Russia on March 8, 1917. Thousands of Russian women took to the streets of the capital, Petrograd, now known as St Petersburg, to demand the end of food shortages and World War I.

It was this International Women's Day protest that helped prompt the start of the Russian Revolution and led to the overthrowing of the czar.

This holiday has been celebrated on March 8 ever since, as it took place on February 23, 1917, on the then-used Julian calendar (the equivalent of March 8 on the Gregorian calendar).

International Women's Day recognized worldwide

The United Nations celebrated International Women's Day for the first time in 1975.

According to Women Watch, the UN General Assembly cited two reasons for deciding to observe the celebration of women's day: the first is to recognize the fact that securing peace and social progress and the full enjoyment of human rights and fundamental freedoms require the active participation, equality and development of women.

The second is to acknowledge the contribution of women to the strengthening of international peace and security

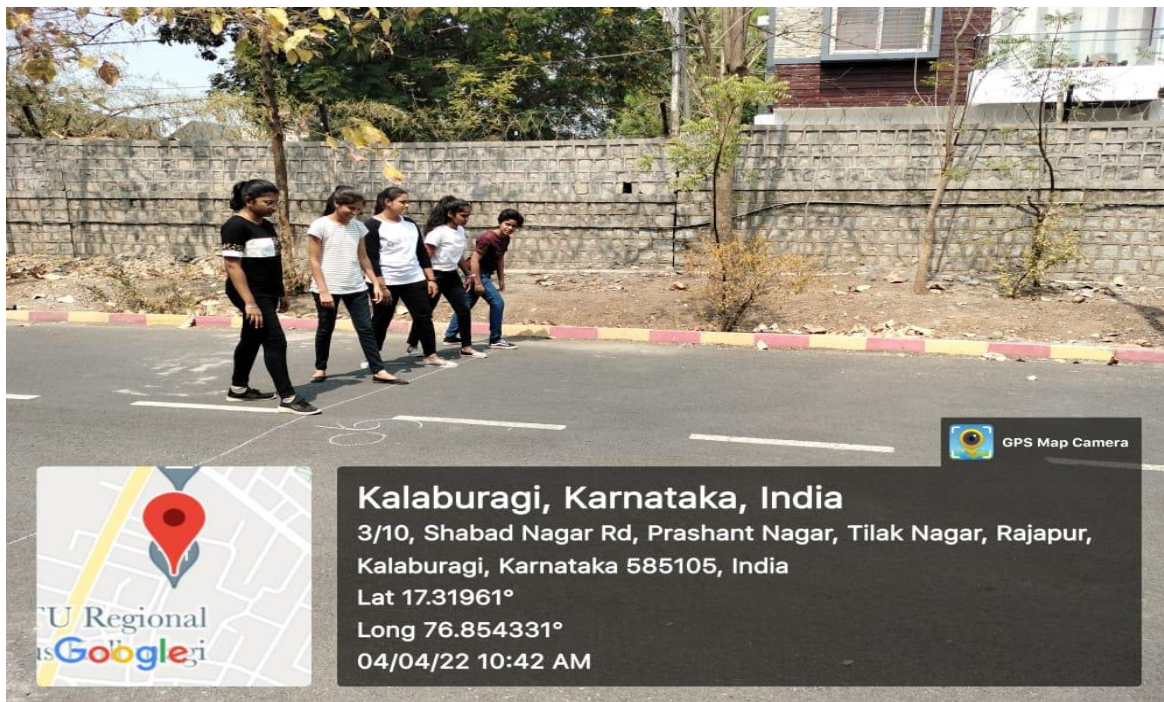

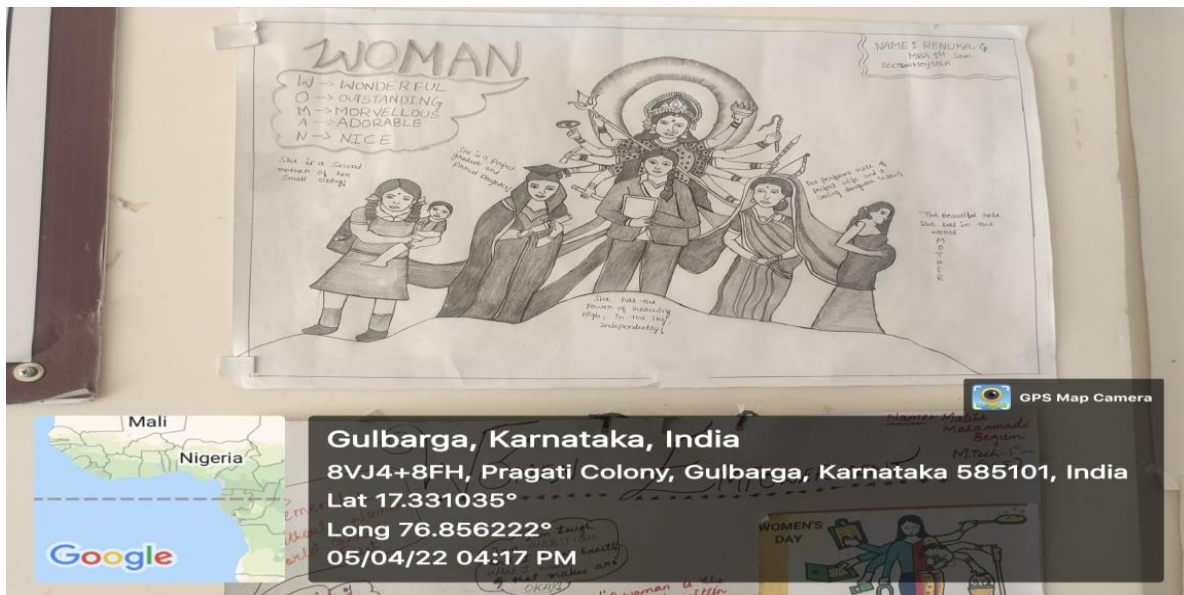

Rangoli art is a traditional form of welcoming good luck and its popularity has remained unaffected over the years. Rangoli competitions are one of the most popular activities during festivals.





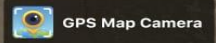
