# The success of SIB 2019 Belagavi India – fourth Indo-Israeli workshop on Sustainable Design

The presentation of participants of the Fourth Indo-Israel certificate program on 'Sustainable Design – Small is Beautiful' will be held on 16 September 2019 at 14.30 to 17.30 hours at the Senate Hall, VTU. The certificate program organized by the Institute of Environmental Architecture (IEAR) Mumbai was successfully conducted in collaboration with the Bezalel Academy of Arts and Design, and the Hebrew University, Jerusalem and hosted by VTU Belagavi.

The success of the program is attributed to the collaborations set up during a roadshow in June by the team of IEAR with experts, NGOs and the local people of Belgaum.

Dr. Smitha Surebankar provided an overview of history, culture and tradition of Belgaum to the team and later conducted the heritage walk for the participants. Mrs. Sunita Hanamshet introduced the team to local houses and to the Rotary club of Belgaum where Mr. Vikrant Kudale, a local from Belgavi offered a visit of his 16- year old house in Shahpur. He also introduced the team to the Ginde family in sonar galli in Shahpur. Both these houses served as case study and site visit for the participants.

Mrs. Hanamshet also conducted a tour of the Vivekanand memorial for the team. Here, Ms. Jyoti Kiran explained about the mission, the exhibit and the restoration work of the Vivekanand memorial. This became one of the site visits in the program. Opposite the Vivekanand memorial, the team made contact with the Uppin family thanks to their hospitality.

The key person in this collaboration is VTU's program coordinator, Asst. Prof. Rohan Gurav from the Land and Water Management Institute. Dr. A. V. Shivpur, Regional Director, VTU, gave his full support for the program. He made it a point to visit the case study houses during the course of the program, a unique gesture for a person of his stature. Rohan Gurav also took the team to Gokhuldham Vedic village, about 25 km from Belagavi. The participants will be taken for a half day tour of this place on Saturday 14 September 2019.

The cultural experience for the Israeli students was enhanced when local students along with Asst. Prof. Rohan Gurav took them to participate in the Ganpati aarti and Ananta Chaturdashi procession on 12 September 2019.

## Belagavi's Lesson to the World - Simple Living High Thinking!

The concluding session of the Fourth Indo-Israel certificate program on Sustainable Design, Small is Beautiful (SIB) 2019, organized by the Institute of Environmental Architecture (IEAR) Mumbai in collaboration with the Bezalel Academy of Arts and Design, and the Hebrew University, Jerusalem, Israel, and hosted by VTU Belagavi, was held on 16th September 2019 at the Senate Hall, VTU.

The session was addressed by Regional Director, VTU, Dr. A. V. Shivapur during the valedictory function. Registrar of VTU, Dr. A.S. Deshpande warmly extended his support for the workshop prior to the valedictory session.

Participants of the workshop – 11 each from India and Israel – working in interdisciplinary groups on community case studies in Belagavi presented their key learnings and vision for sustainability.

Family values, simplistic living, connection with the land, sentimental value for work and continuing traditions that bind the community – these are some of the key values that were highlighted by the 5 interdisciplinary groups.

Creating a historic preservation map to identify heritage sites and buildings, recognizing the needs of an aging population, generating jobs for youth who are migrating outside and maintaining the urban aesthetics while Belagavi transforms from a small town to a smart city – were the key challenges that were identified by participants.

The groups unanimously cited the urgent need to create a master plan to preserve the cultural and architectural heritage of Belagavi. Smart city must take into consideration environment, social and economic sustainability of Belagavi while highlighting on the values upheld by generations of families settled in Belagavi. Practical solutions to address the light and ventilation needs and reducing energy consumption in the traditional mud houses were suggested by participants.

The five case studies identified included the Kudale residence in Shahpur, the Uppin residence opposite Vivekanand memorial and the Bhatkande residence in Piranwadi. The family members of these case studies attended the final presentations and appreciated the efforts of the participants. The site visits included the nearly 200 year old Ginde family mud house, the Vivekanand memorial, the Gokuldham Eco-village, Chikale falls, AEQUS and wind mills site at Kati hills. The workshop was unique in that most of the learning happened in the field. Participants summarized their learning from the site visits and also the cultural experience of dancing and participating in the Ganpati visarjan on Ananta Chaturdeshi.

Dr. Roshni Udyavar Yehuda, President IEAR stated: "Never has SIB been such a grand success as it was in Belagavi. The final goal of the workshop, sustainable design, was achieved through the multi-cultural and

interdisciplinary participation. The most important part was the hospitality of the people of Belagavi." Prof. Elad Persov of the Bezalel Academy of Arts and Design was 'overwhelmed' by the cultural experience and thanked the people of Belagavi for their whole-hearted support. Asst. Prof. Rohan Gurav of the Water and Land Management, Dept of Civil Engg, VTU Belagavi, which hosted the workshop at Belagavi, stated: "This workshop has set a new benchmark in the University. We are looking forward to further collaborations with IEAR in the field of sustainable design."


