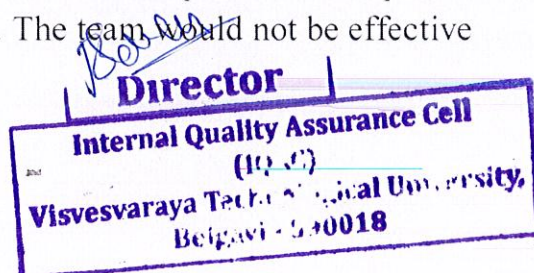


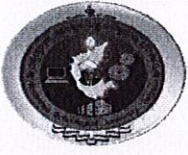
Mr. Girish Started with quote

"Every choice you make has an end result."

Realizing that aspects of our personalities are engaged at various levels every day at home, work and play is one thing. Understanding how to use that knowledge is another. But it is important. Being able to identify personality types can help us exert our influence, improve relationships

Educate sales team on the different personality styles. Ask them to identify the personality styles of their existing customers. Find out which styles they sell to most easily. Find out which ones are most difficult. Role-play modifying personality styles to improve their skill at identifying and modifying based on the style of the buyer. It's important to remember that focusing on these skills must include consistent practice. In order for a sports team to perform well they need to practice plays during the week. The team would not be effective
