One day workshop on topic 'Block Chain Technology' is being conducted under Indian Society for Technical Education (ISTE) students chapter held on 09 January 2020 at 09.30 am to 04.30 pm in two sessions morning and afternoon in the seminar hall at Visvesvaraya Technological University, Centre for PG studies, Kalaburagi. This event is organized by Department of Computer Science and Engineering under ISTE student's chapter VTU Kalaburagi. The resource person Ms. Anupama, Industry expert handled the sessions of the workshop.



The resource person handled the session on:

Block chain Technology

The expert briefed about importance of Block Chain Technology

Blockchain Technology is the most promising technology of the 21st century. Many have compared the blockchain technology's potential significance to that of the internet. The fact that blockchain is a decentralised way of storing and accessing data makes the whole system incredibly secure – because, unlike a centralised database, there's no one single point of entry for hackers. This makes it particularly useful for recording transactions in a secure manner.

The blockchain technology is a decentralized ledger that keeps a record of transactions that takes place across a peer-to-peer network. This technology allows participants from across

the network to confirm their transaction without the need for a central authority, this includes money transactions, voting, and settling trades and many more.

How does it work?

If someone requests for a transaction, this transaction is then broadcasted to a P2P network that consists of computers which are known as nodes. The sole purpose of these nodes is to validate the transaction and the status of the user using algorithms. Now this verified transaction can either involve cryptocurrency, records, transactions or any kind of other data. This verified transaction is then combined with other transactions that create another block of data. The block of data is then added to the existing blockchain. This blockchain cannot be altered and is permanent.

The expert also discussed about the impact of blockchain technology and decentralization:

• Security purposes

The digital world is filled with hackers looking to breach information or steal data from sources. With blockchain technology, the information stored has robust security making it impossible for one to back.

Transparency

Since everything is displayed on the network, there are very fewer chances that there would be any kind of discrepancy that can be created.

• It is inexpensive

Most of the traditional financial models that are available in the market are expensive, however, with blockchain it is inexpensive.

• Less transaction time

An individual can send, receive money and financial documents within a couple of minutes, this reduces the burden of waiting for hours together.

• Financial efficiency is increased

Decentralized blockchain allows one to make transactions from individual to individual without the involvement of the third party. This help saves a lot of money while making transactions, unlike traditional banks.

• Protect businesses from fraud

The blockchain is open source ledgers which is why it is very easy to identify if fraud has taken place since every transaction is recorded on them.

The industries disrupted by blockchain

The banking sector isn't the only industry that has been impacted by blockchain technology. Other sectors like law firms or law enforcement are other industries that can be disrupted by blockchain technologies.

The expert also discussed application areas using block chain:

- The banking sector blockchain is said to be the safest way to store banking records and probably the easiest and cheapest means in transferring funds through the decentralization provided by blockchain.
- Voting voting irregularities could be minimized with the help of blockchain technology. Everything can be secured through blockchain, from casting votes to tallying the votes, the system is said to be indisputable.

- Healthcare managing records of patients could be a pain during the past, but this isn't the case today. Today, doctors can easily access patients health records and track them regardless of how many times you have changed the doctors.
- Real estate buying and selling land requires a lot of paperwork but with blockchain, the process is much easier and simpler.
- The legal industry storing legal documents, retrieving them and verifying are the key functions that include in the legal industry. And the questions raised over the legality of wills and other important documents can be eliminated by implementing blockchain secured documents.
- The government in a government sector, corruption can be eliminated using blockchain technologies. For instance, employment, welfare, and disability benefits can be distinguished and distributed in a much easier manner.

Over the next decade, there will be new blockchain ideas that would emerge, few might be a success and a failure. But during the process, there will also be some great problems that will be solved with the emergence of new models.



Mr. Arvind S. Benal. he has delivered a lecture on "case studies of Big Data". He explained that, Big data comes from myriad different sources, such as business transaction systems, customer databases, medical records, internet clickstream logs, mobile applications, social networks, scientific research repositories, machine-generated data and real-time data sensors used in internet of things (IoT) environments. The data may be left in its raw form in big data systems or

preprocessed using data mining tools or data preparation software so it's ready for particular analytics uses.

Big data also encompasses a wide variety of data types, including the following:

- structured data in databases and data warehouses based on Structured Query Language (SQL);
- unstructured data, such as text and document files held in Hadoop clusters or NoSQL database systems; and
- semistructured data, such as web server logs or streaming data from sensors.

Two days workshop on topic 'Cloud , Edge and Fog computing' is being conducted under Indian Society for Technical Education (ISTE) students chapter held on 30th and 31st December 2019 at 09.30 am to 05.30 pm in two sessions morning in the seminar hall and afternoon hand held session in laboratory at Visvesvaraya Technological University, Center for PG studies, Kalaburagi. This event is organized by Department of M.C.A under ISTE students chapter VTU Kalaburagi. The resource person Dr. Pethuraj, Vice- president and Chief Architect, Reliance Jio handled the two days sessions.



The following topics were discussed on first day of workshop:

- Cloud Computing.
- Edge Computing.
- Fog Computing.

The experts briefed about all these with the explosion of data, devices and interactions, cloud architecture on its own can't handle the influx of information. While the cloud gives us access to compute, storage and even connectivity that we can access easily and cost-effectively, these centralized resources can create delays and performance issues for devices and data that are

far from a centralized public cloud or data center source. Fog and edge computing are both extensions of cloud networks, which are a collection of servers comprising a distributed network. Such a network can allow an organization to greatly exceed the resources that would otherwise be available to it, freeing organizations from the requirement to keep infrastructure on site. The primary advantage of cloud-based systems is they allow data to be collected from multiple sites and devices, which is accessible anywhere in the world.

The cloud layer is thus able to benefit from IIoT devices by receiving their data through the other layers. Organizations often achieve superior results by integrating a cloud platform with on-site fog networks or edge devices. Most enterprises are now migrating towards a fog or edge infrastructure to increase the utilization of their end-user and IIoT devices.

Experts brifed about the Edge computing also known as just "edge" brings processing close to the data source, and it does not need to be sent to a remote cloud or other centralized systems for processing. By eliminating the distance and time it takes to send data to centralized sources, we can improve the speed and performance of data transport, as well as devices and applications on the edge. Edge computing is an extension of older technologies such as peer-to-peer networking, distributed data, self-healing network technology and remote cloud services. It's powered by small form factor hardware with flash-storage arrays that provide highly optimized performance. The processors used in edge computing devices offer improved hardware security with a low power requirement. WINSYSTEMS' industrial embedded SBCs and data acquisition modules provide gateways for the data flow to and from an organization's computing environments.

Experts also focused on Fog computing which is a standard that defines how edge computing should work, and it facilitates the operation of compute, storage and networking services between end devices and cloud computing data centers. Additionally, many use fog as a jumping-off point for edge computing. Fog computing uses edge devices and gateways with the LAN providing processing capability. These devices need to be efficient, meaning they require little power and produce little heat. WINSYSTEMS' single-board computers (SBCs) can be used in a fog environment to receive real-time data such as response time (latency), security and data volume, which can be distributed across multiple nodes in a network.

More than 50 students and faculties were participated in two days workshop on "Cloud, Edge and Fog" Computing.


Importance of Android Studio





This programme is organised to sensitise the student community about the policies and programmes provided by Government. Educational schemes for marginalized communities such as SC/ST were introduced by the Government of India with the aim of providing equal opportunity for scheduled tribe and scheduled caste to empower them with free educational facilities. For such programs to be effective, SC/ST members need to be aware of them and need to have a positive attitude towards them. However, due to the practice of un touch ability and the remoteness of their dwellings, SCs and STs have suffered isolation from mainstream population for several centuries. As a consequence, they continue to suffer from a high degree of educational exclusion. SCs and STs, both



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economically and socially, will be only possible through inclusive education efforts. This study focuses on the role of awareness on educational schemes in attaining

Primary and secondary education among SC/ST communities in two rural villages in Coimbatore. The major findings of the study reveals that most of marginalized communities continue to remain unaware of the educational schemes and are unable to utilize all the provisions of the schemes.
