Report on 2nd 'SAMVETA' Alumni Meet

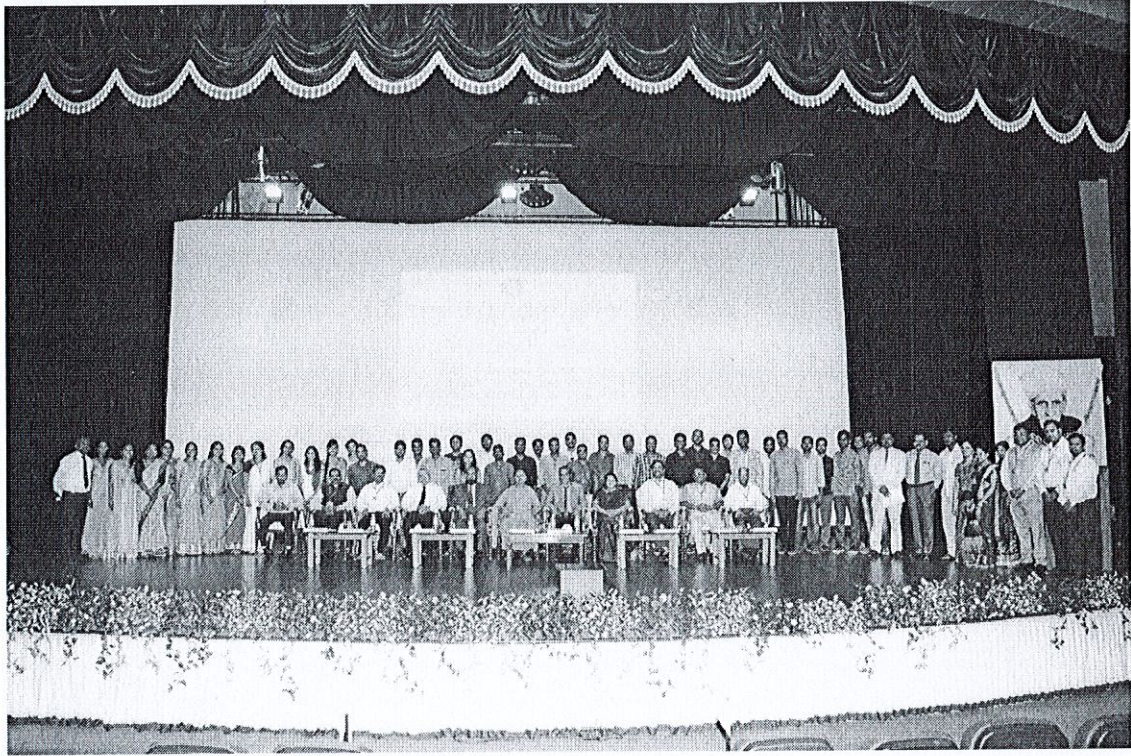
