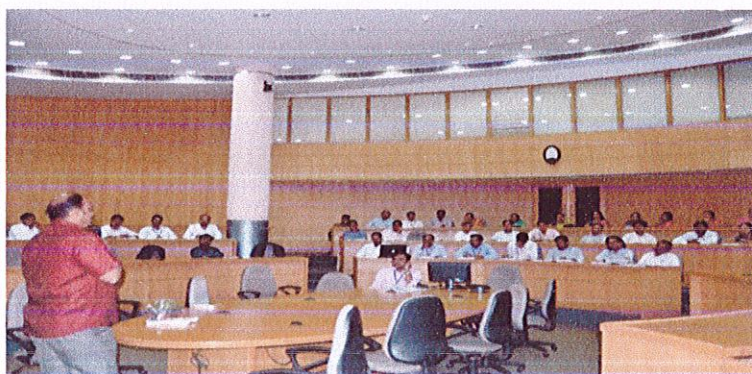

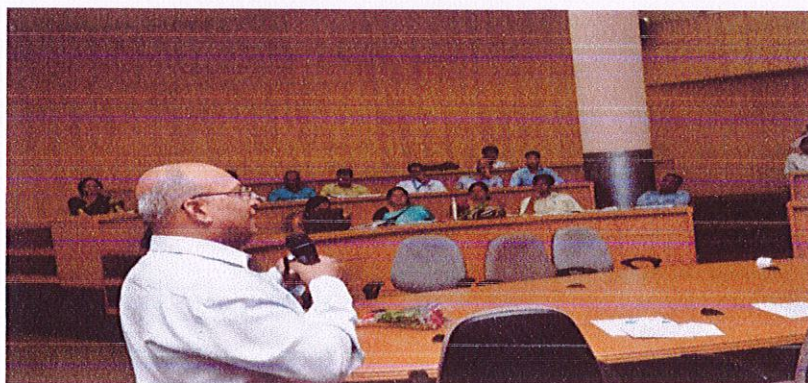

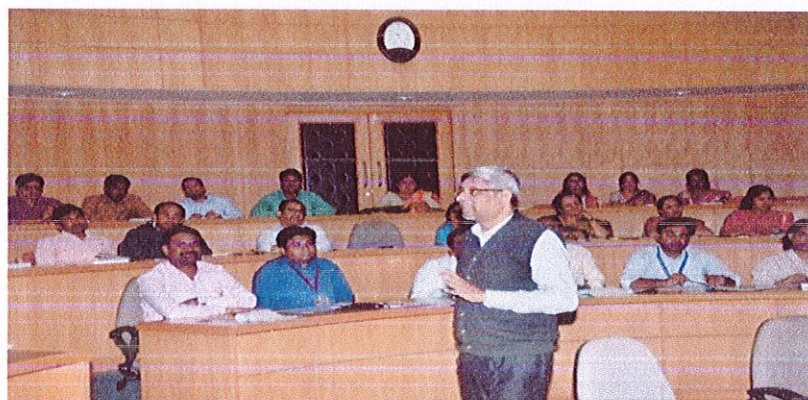

3rd Day (20/02/2019) Session I:

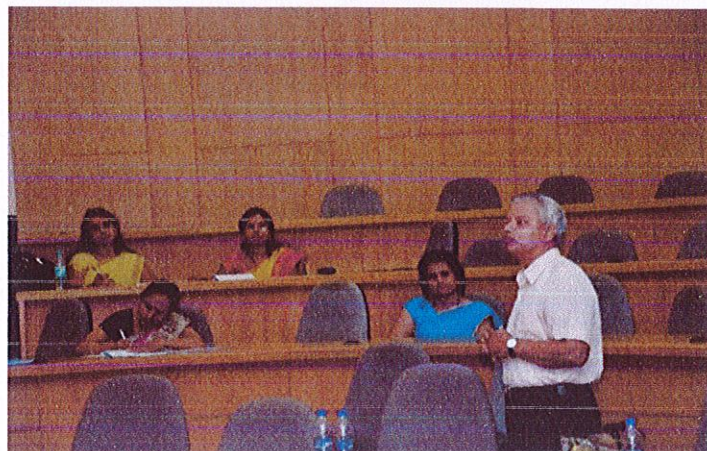
