### **Report of Faculty Development Programme**

#### **Date: 24th June 2019 (First day)**

##### **Inaugural Session:**

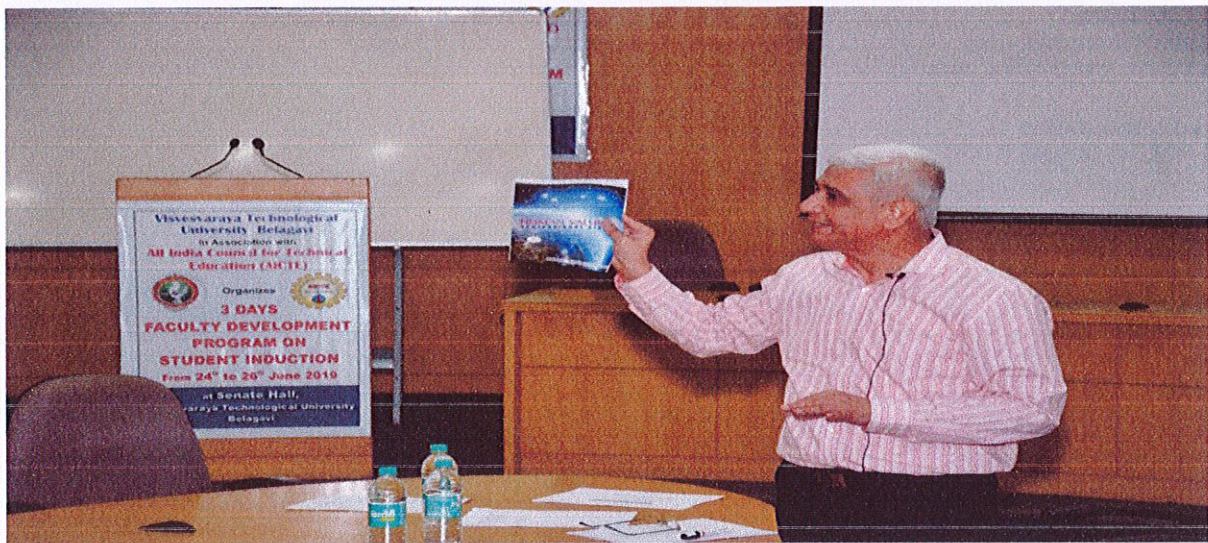

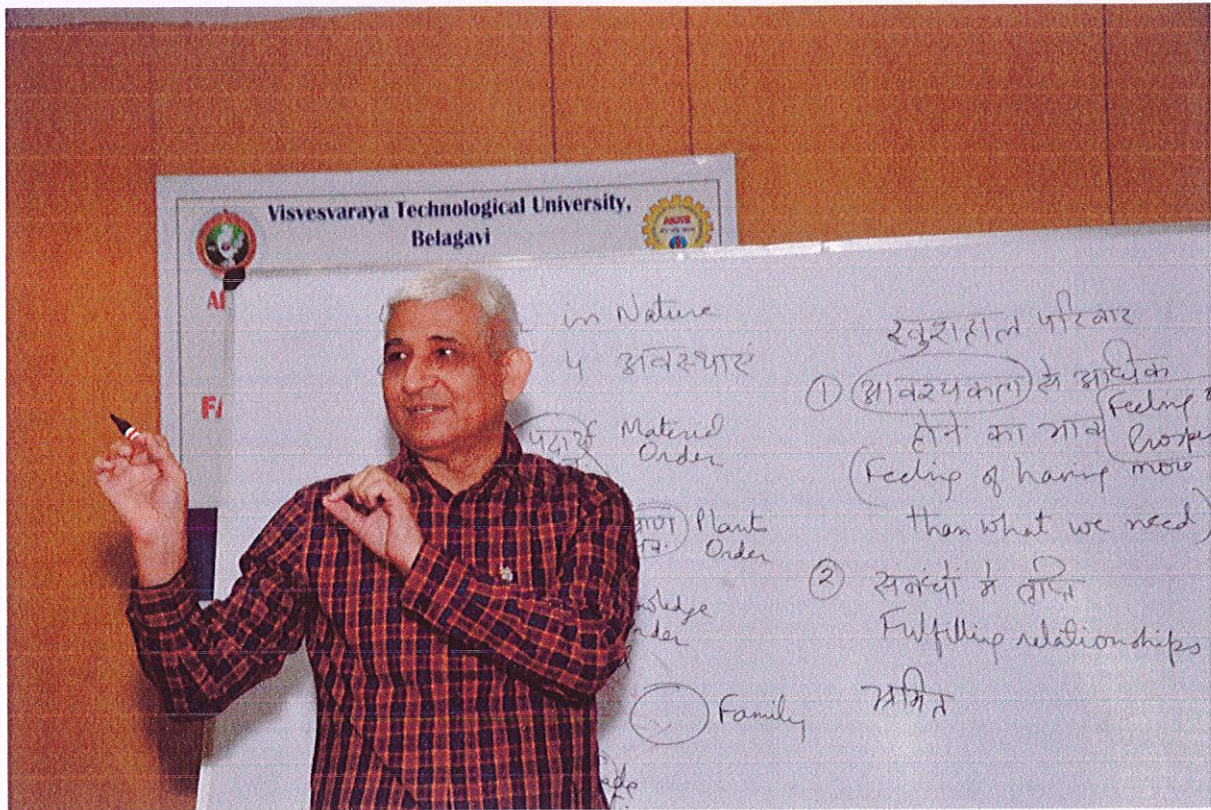

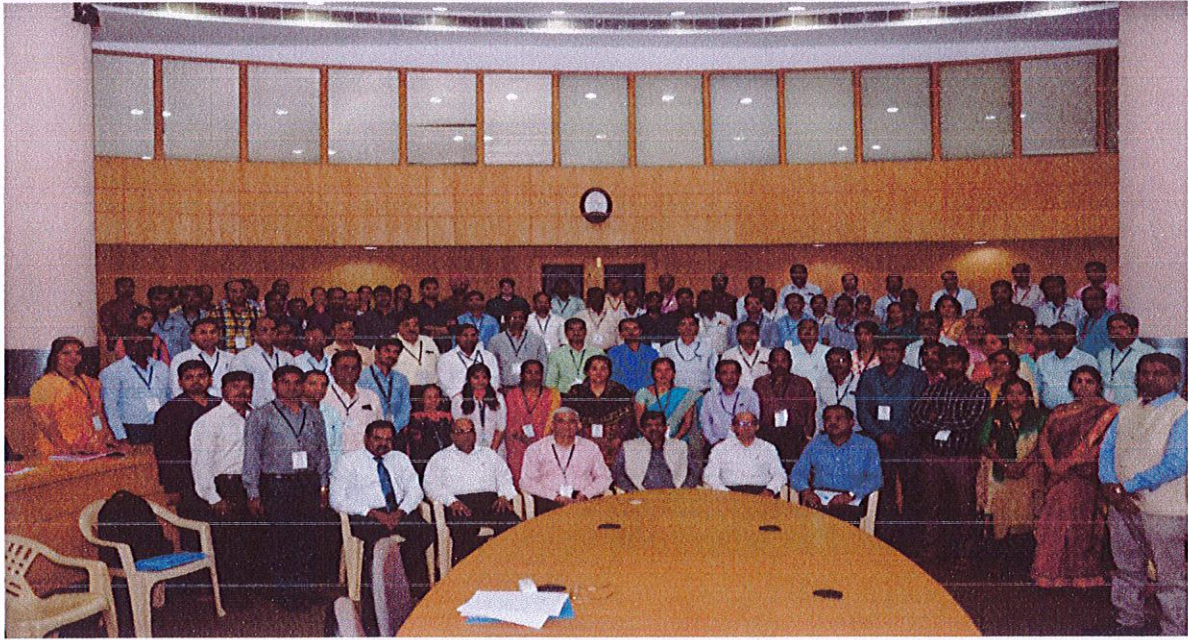
### Date: 26<sup>th</sup> June 2019 (Third Day):

The resource Person enlightened everyone on the concept of continuous Happiness. He emphasized the theory of Harmony in family and how is it important to achieve happiness in family. Mr chopra narrated various thirty universal values existing in one's life. Mr Sanjeevchopra explained the three categories where these thirty values are taken from its basically value in self, value of human being and established values. He explained few values in details to name a few like Happiness, Peace, trust, care and reverence. He lead all the concepts by real time examples which made the participants understand the concept more effectively.

The following feedback was received from the participants:

- 1) 90% of the participants felt that the delivery and presentation of the person was good
- 2) 95% of the participants were of the opinion that the FDP brought practical knowledge of the subject in them.
- 3) 80% of the participants felt that the FDP was coordinated very well.
