STATUTE RELATING TO CREATION POWERS AND FUNCTIONS OF DIRECTORS OF REGIONAL CENTERS

(framed under sections 18 and 29 of VTU Act, 1994)

1. TITLE AND COMMENCEMENT:

- i) This Statute shall be called 'Statute Relating to the Creation, Powers and Functions of Directors of Regional Centres of Visveswaraiah Technological University'.
- ii) This shall come into effect from the date of assent by the Chancellor.

2. NUMBER OF REGIONAL CENTERS:

- i) The Executive Council can create Regional Centres and assign colleges to each centre, depending on the work load and accessibility.
- ii) Each Regional Centre will be headed by a Director, supported by the required staff.
- iii) The University shall create the necessary infrastructure for effective functioning of the Regional Centre.

3. APPOINTMENT:

- i) The Director shall be appointed by the Executive Council on the recommendation of the Vice-Chancellor for a period of two years on such terms and conditions as it may deem fit.
- The term of the director may be extended for a maximum of a further period of two years by the Executive Council on the recommendation of the Vice-Chancellor.
- The person proposed for the post of Director by the Vice-Chancellor may be from Academic departments of the University, Officers of the University, Constituent and affiliated colleges of the University or from other reputed institutions / organizations.

. POWERS AND FUNCTIONS:

The Directors of the Regional Centres shall have the following powers and functions:

- To receive, process and forward examination application as per the directions of the i) University.
- To issue and receive affiliation applications from the Institutions as per the ii) directions of the University.
- To report to the University any problems or matters of the concerned region which iii) needs the attention and clarification from the University.
- ·To convene and conduct meetings on behalf of the University as per the directions iv) of the University.
- To inspect and report regarding any matter pertaining to the institutions in the V) Region referred to by the University.
- To receive any letter, representation, application etc., addressed to the Univeersity vi) on behalf of the University.
- To serve as Information Centre regarding curriculum, calender of events, details of vii) courses of instructions.
- Different fees to be paid, affiliation matters, and such other matters connected with viii) academic and administration of the University and also to supply the necessary forms and other materials required by the students and the institutions.
- To supervise the overall functioning of the centre. ix)
- To exercise such other financial and administrative powers as directed by the X) University.
- The Directorate of Regional Centre shall, wherever required, co-ordinate and guide xi) the activities of placement and training centres of the institutes towards providing information regarding employment and arranging campus interviews, etc. It shall also advice the University regarding steps to be taken to strengthen these placement and training centres to be more effective and helpful to the students.
- In general, to act as Liaison Officer between the Colleges, Students, Government, xii) Statutory Bodies, Industries and the University as per the guidelines and instructions of the University.

To do such other functions as may be assigned by the University from time to time. Xiii)

The Vice Chancellor welcomed the members and introduced three members, namely, Prof. N. R. Shetty and Sri V. B. Bellad as the new members of the Executive Council and the new Registrar Dr. H. V. Sudhaker Nayak, who has taken charge on 02-03-2002. He briefed the members about the ongoing activities of the University.

The First Convocation of VTU: The Vice Chancellor informed the members about the First Convocation of the University which is going to be organized on 20-04-2002 at the University Campus, Machche, Belgaum. He informed the members that Her Excellency, the Governor of Kamataka and Chancellor of the University will be presiding over the Convocation. Prof. R. Natarajan, Chairman, AICTE, will deliver the Convocation Address. Dr. G. Parameshwar, Hon'ble

Minister for Higher Education and Medical Education, will be present on the occasion. He also stated that Bharatha Ratna Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam will be conferred the Degree of Doctor of Science (Honoris Causa) on the occasion.

- Progress in construction activity of VTU Campus at Machche, Belgaum: The Vice Chancellor stated that the construction of phase-I buildings is going on at a brisk pace. By the end of May about 70 to 80% of the building will be ready. The construction of Administrative Block will be completed by the end of July. The inauguration of the building is likely to take place in the month of August 2002.
- Regional Centers of VTU: Vice Chancellor stated that identification of land for the Regional Centres of VTU at Bangalore, Mysore and Gulbarga, is in progress and the University is likely to acquire the required land very soon.
- Starting of M.Tech. Programmes in the University: Vice Chancellor informed that the M.Tech. Programmes will be started in the regional centers of VTU and also at Malnad College of Engineering, Hassan, from the academic year 2002-03.
- MoU with INTEL and iiit-b: INTEL Asia Electronics Inc. has signed an MoU jointly with iiit-b and VTU. As per the MoU, a series of nine Teachers' Training Workshops (CEEP) will be organized for VTU teachers and researchers. It is five day package (lecture-com-demonstration and lab-sessions) to the faculty of engineering colleges free of cost. The teacher is treated on duty and the training is recognized and is directly linked to the academic performance evaluation. At the end of the year about 300 teachers will get trained. Resource persons for training are derived from IISc/IITs and other leading industries.
- University Exhibition: Vice Chancellor told that during the CET examination, the University proposes to hold an exhibition at Chitrakala Parishath, Bangalore, involving all the affiliated engineering colleges of VTU. He expressed that such an exhibition, along with the Information Brochure produced by the University, will cater all the required information needed during CET Counselling, about the colleges for the students willing to opt for engineering course in the State. CDs of VTU and Affiliated colleges will also be made available during the exhibition.
- Strong Rooms in the colleges; Vice Chancellor impressed upon the Principals to have Strong Rooms in their colleges for the safety of question papers during the time of examination.

(9). Establishment of Biodiversity Park in VTU Campus.

NOTE: University wishes to have a Biodiversity Park in its sprawling campus. On its request the ecologists from Eco-Watch Environment Centre visited and surveyed the campus on 25th January 2005. The campus is found to be ideal for establishing a Biodiversity Park. The main objectives for the establishment of Biodiversity Park are:

- Restoration of indigenous natural vegetation
- Establishment of an Arboretum
- Establishment of a garden of Medicinal Plants
- Creation of grove consisting of species of plants considered sacred in Indian tradition.
- Promotion of species congenial for enhancing the diversity of Butterflies.
- Creation of Nectar Grove using appropriate species, which promote honey bees
- Establishment of a garden for Wild Flowers of the Western Ghats
- Enrichment of the campus with food and fruit plants from the wild.

The Eco-Watch Environment Centre has furnished the Action Plan along with the expenditure statement to set up this Biodiversity Park at VTU. The estimated cost for the establishment of this park has been worked out to be Rs.6,45,000/-.

Now, the proposal is placed before the Executive Council for consideration and approval.

(17). Approval for 10% of initial amount (Rs.60,000) paid towards Swajaladara Water Supply Scheme to Santibastwad Adopted Village of VTU.

NOTE: VTU has adopted Santibastwad Village near its Campus and various developmental activities by the University is under progress in this village. From February, 2004 to June, 2004, drinking water was supplied to the villagers through tankers, as there was scarcity of drinking water in this part. A bore-well was also drilled to supply the water, but there was insufficient yield.

Now, Zilla Panchayat Engineering Sub-Division, Belgaum, has prepared a plan to supply water under Swajaladhara Scheme. Estimated Cost is Rs. 6.00 lakhs. 10% of the cost is to be borne by the villagers. Secretary and President of Village Panchayat, Santibastwad requested to pay 10% contribution of Rs.60,000/- for the scheme. As a part of the developmental activity, the Vice Chancellor has permitted to pay the Villager's contribution. Now the action of the Vice Chancellor is placed before the Executive Council for ratification.

17. Resolved to ratify the action of the Vice Chancellor for having permitted for the payment of 10% of initial amount (i.e. Rs.60,000/-) towards Swajaladhara Water Supply Scheme to Santibastwad Adopted Village of VTU.

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(18). Purchase/Acquisition of land R.Sy.No.562 for VTU at Belgaum.

NOTE: VTU is having 115 acres of land granted by the Govt. of Karnataka and it has already completed Phase-I building work in this land. Now the University is proposing to take up Phase-II works for which the University will face land problem for the further expansion. Therefore, purchase / acquisition of land adjacent to VTU land is thought of. There is about 12 acres of private land (Sy.No.562) on the northern side adjacent to VTU Compound Wall (On both sides of Main Entrance Gate) owned by two parties. If the said land is purchased / acquired, it will be useful for the University to develop Bio-diversity Garden to grow medicinal and herbal plants. By purchasing / acquiring the above land, the acquisition of adjacent forest land can also be requested from the Forest Authorities for maintenance. Thus, the land up to Jamboti Road can be utilized by the University. The Revenue map is enclosed for reference.

The matter is placed before the Executive Council for consideration and necessary direction.

18. Executive Council resolved to purchase/acquire the land R.Sy.No.562 adjacent to University Campus, near the north entrance gate, for VTU.
