A mandatory UHV-II course in AICTE's model curriculum is the first tangible input on values for the students. The Student Induction Program (SIP) based on UHV (UHV-I in AICTE's Model Curriculum) can provide an orientation to students for such a holistic education. Colleges are required to develop the requisite teaching capacity for both. As indicated in the Approval Process Handbook 2020-21, Each college must prepare at least 1 UHV faculty for every 20 newly joined students. Faculty must be prepared from every department/branch/discipline over the next three years.
