General Guidelines/Rules for Project work of 6th semester MCA

Guidelines for CIE:

- 01 There shall be three project presentations each to be considered for 5 marks **(5X3= 15 marks)** at the end of every month.
- 02 At the end of the semester a **final presentation for 15 marks** to be taken covering the entire project. Students' Presentations may be using PowerPoint presentations/ demonstrations of the work.
- 03 Synopsis submitted in a proper format (as approved by the department) is to be evaluated for **10 marks**. In synopsis, students shall highlight the problem statement, solution, new/innovation of the solution, methodology, tools /languages adopted, outcomes, usefulness to the industry, society/environment, and economical advantages if any. Students shall submit the initial synopsis and final synopsis where the final synopsis shall address all the said points.
- 04 Rubrics shall be followed in all the project evaluations.
- 05 Each assessment of the project course namely phase-wise presentations, final presentation, and synopsis shall be mapped to defined course outcomes of the Project course, and rubrics designed for evaluation shall be announced to the students at the beginning of the Semester.

Guidelines for SEE

- 01 Both internal and external examiners shall evaluate the Thesis/Dissertation report for **30 marks** and the average of the marks shall be considered. The students shall follow the report format as prescribed by the University. However, as per the title/domain/type of the project with a suitable justification guide/department can make the minor changes.
- 02 Project Viva-voce examination shall be conducted for **30 marks** jointly by internal and external examiners:
 - **Project presentation has to be considered for 10 marks** (5 marks for organized relevant content/ + 5 marks presentation (communication) skills,
 - **10 marks for demonstrating** knowledge/skills/ modern tool usage/ innovation industry exposure/research and investigation of complex problems in the projectwork.
