“TAGORE AWARD FOR CULTURAL HARMONY ”

Ref: Notification from the Governor's Secretariat vide : No. GS 21 GUM 2021, dt:20-08-2022

The Ministry of Culture, Tourism and Development of North Eastern Region, Government of India, New Delhi has requested the Hon'ble Governor of Karnataka to send the State Nominations for the Award of the “**Tagore Award for Cultural Harmony**”. The Tagore Award for Cultural Harmony was instituted by the Government of India from 2012 recognizing the contributions made by Shri Gurudev Rabindranath Tagore to humanity at large with his works and ideas, as part of the Commemoration of his 150th Birth Anniversary in 2012, for promoting values of Cultural Harmony. He was also the first Indian to receive the Nobel Prize. **The award carries an amount of Rs. One Crore (convertible to foreign currency), a citation in a Scroll, a Plaque as well as an exquisite traditional handicraft / handloom item.** Accordingly, the Governor's Secretariat has constituted a committee consisting of the Vice –Chancellors of different Universities of the State under the Chairmanship of the Vice Chancellor of VTU, Belagavi, to invite the proposals from Persons / Associations / Institution / Organisation and submit its recommendations.

Hence, proposals are invited from the Persons/Associations/Institutions/ Organisations for the said Award.


The following Persons/Associations/Institutions/Organisations are competent to make proposals for the award:-

1. Nobel Laureates for the last five years;
2. Council of Ministers of Central Government;
3. Member of Parliament of India except Council of Ministers;
4. The Secretary-General, United Nations/Commonwealth/ Commonwealth Parliamentary Union/Inter-Parliamentary Union/ and other international organizations or institutions whose objectives are promotion of Cultural Harmony;
5. Heads of Indian Missions abroad for bringing it to the notice of and for consulting major relevant institutions and experts of the country concerned;
6. Presiding Officers of Lok Sabha/State Assemblies/Councils;
7. Governors/Chief Ministers of the States/UTs Administration;
8. Winners of Gandhi Peace Prize, Nehru Award and Indira Gandhi Prize for the last five years;
9. Bharat Ratna Awardees for the last five years;
10. Jnanapeetha Awardees for the last five years;
11. Any other person whom the Jury may wish to invite to make proposals for the Award;
12. Persons who have received the Award.

The proposals for the nominations to the award shall be submitted to **The Vice-Chancellor, Visvesvaraya Technological University, Jnana Sangama, Belagavi – 560 018, through mail to (vc@vtu.ac.in or registrarvtubelagavi@gmail.com) on or before 25.08.2022.**
