- Number of Participants: 2 members
- Participants has to bring their own necessary stationery

- Mode of Presentation: Art Piece, Model, installation
- Number of Participants: 2 - 4 members in one team
- Capture your creative process! A mandatory video documenting the procurement, creation of your junk art piece to be made
