2. Grain art

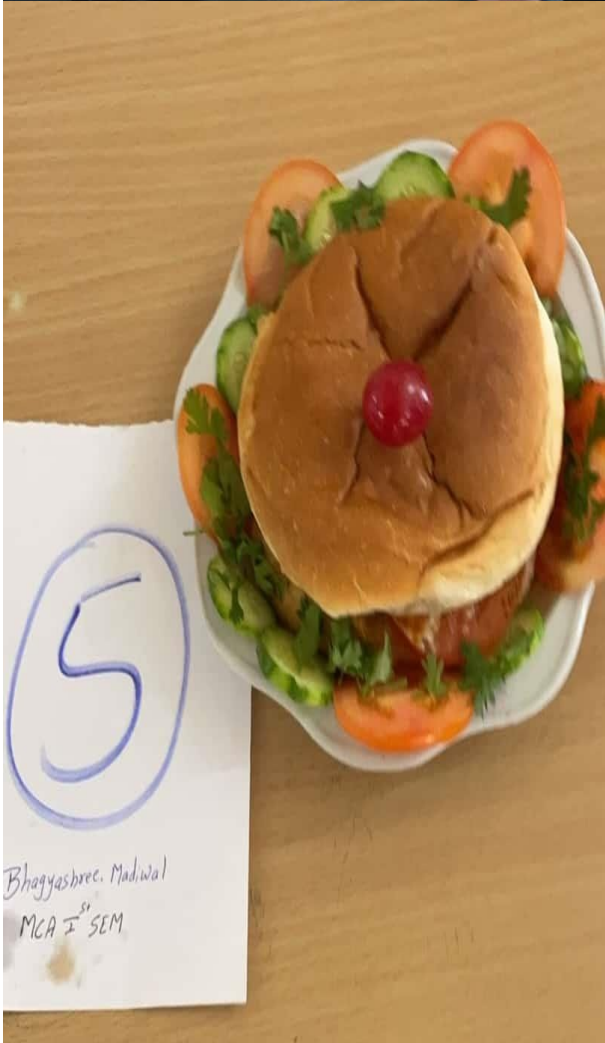

3. Cook without fire

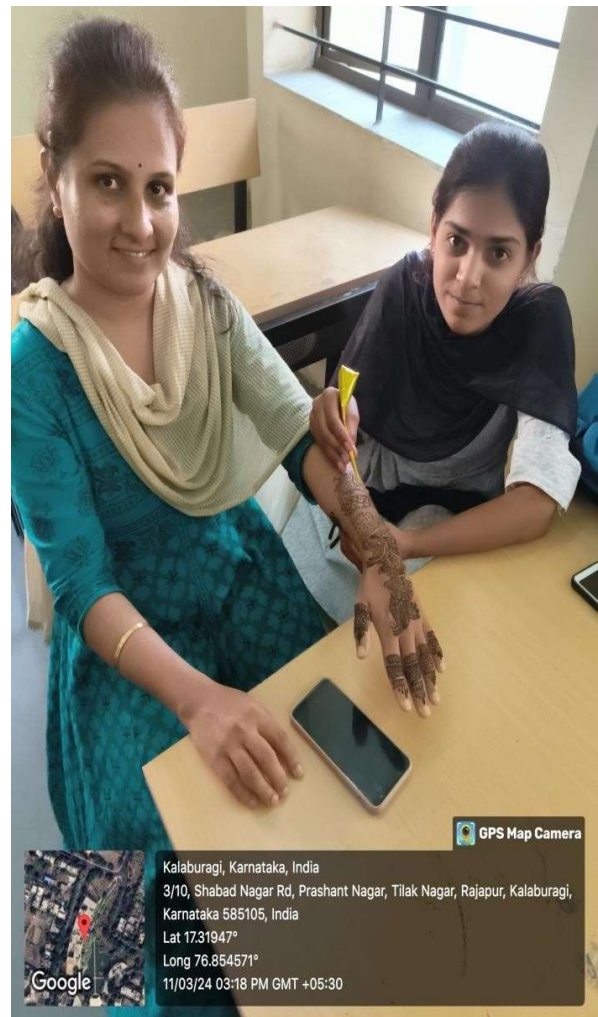
Next event i.e Cook without fire started at 12pm to till 1:30pm in LH 06 of VTU CPGS KALABURAGI.

3 .Mehendi

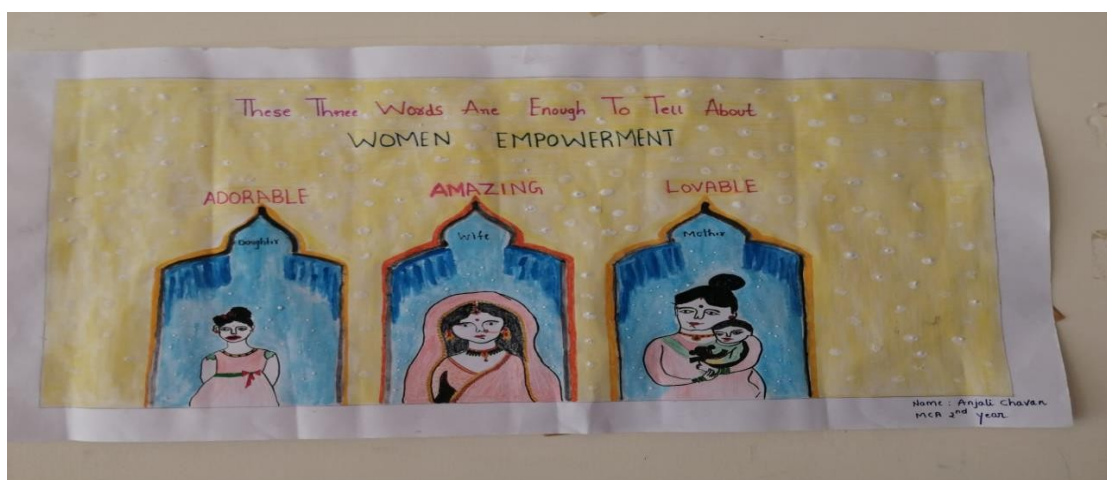

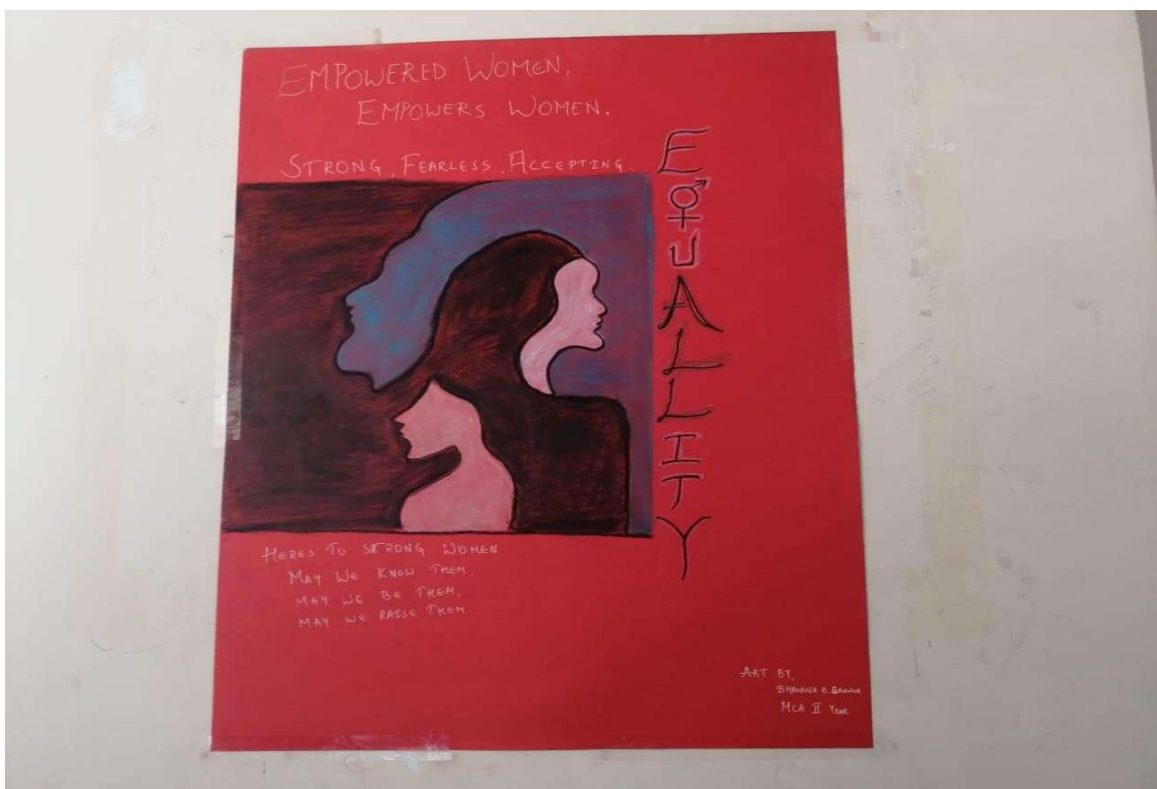
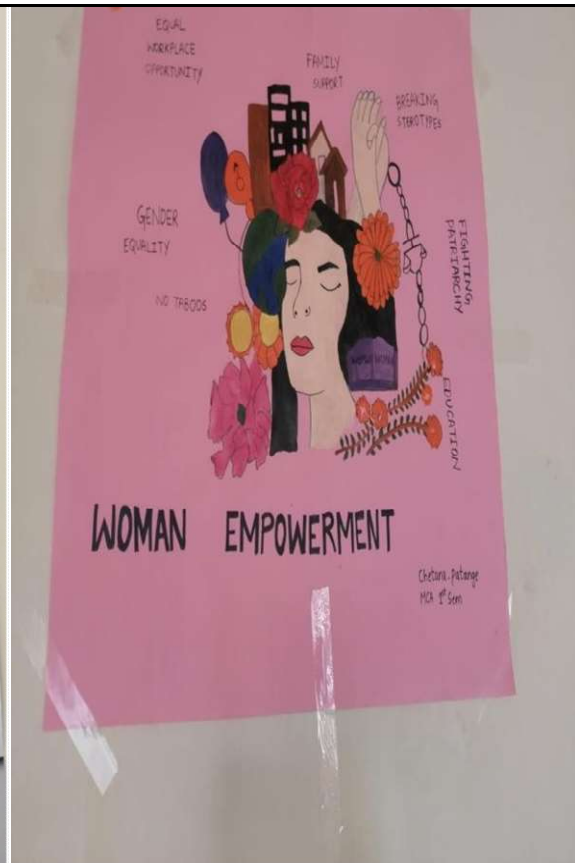




5. Poster presentation competition
