The third day was celebrated as Indo-western day. Celebrating women's day as an Indo-western day involves blending traditional Indian attire with contemporary western styles.






### PROP DAY /MISMATCH DAY (7<sup>TH</sup> MARCH 2024)


# STATES OF INDIA (11<sup>TH</sup> MARCH 2024)


#### 1. Web Page Design






#### 3. Mehendi





#### 5. Posterpresentation competition






Welcoming The Dignitaries
