Subject: Selection of the Sport/NSS/Yoga in 2022 scheme between III to VI semesters

regarding...

Reference: The Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor's approval Dated: 19.09.2024

Under the 2022 scheme, National Service Scheme (NSS), Physical Education (PE) (Sports and Athletics), and Yoga activities should be conducted between the 3rd and 6th semesters. Colleges are required to submit the Continuous Internal Evaluation (CIE) marks for the activities completed by students under selected course each semester.

However, due to a typographical error in 2022 scheme carried over from the 2021 scheme, it incorrectly states that the course selected (out of Physical Education/NSS/Yoga) in the 3rd semester should be continued through to the 6th semester. In reality, students should be allowed to engage in different activities/course each semester. For example, a student who participates in sports in the 3rd semester could choose to undertake NSS in the next semester and Yoga in another semester. This approach aligns with the student-centric focus of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2022 and helps distribute the workload related Physical Education/NSS/Yoga of more evenly across different departments.

All the Principals of Affiliated /Constituent Engineering Colleges are hereby informed to allow the students to take different activities/course out of Physical Education/NSS/Yoga between 3rd to 6th semesters.

Mini-project work: Mini Project is a laboratory-oriented/hands on course that will provide a platform to students to enhance their practical knowledge and skills by the development of small systems/applications etc. Based on the ability/abilities of the student/s and recommendations of the mentor, a single discipline or a multidisciplinary Mini- project can be assigned to an individual student or to a group having not more than 4 students.

CIE procedure for Mini-project:

- (i) Single discipline: The CIE marks shall be awarded by a committee consisting of the Head of the concerned Department and two faculty members of the Department, one of them being the Guide. The CIE marks awarded for the Mini-project work shall be based on the evaluation of the project report, project presentation skill, and question and answer session in the ratio of 50:25:25. The marks awarded for the project report shall be the same for all the batches mates.
- (ii) Interdisciplinary: Continuous Internal Evaluation shall be group-wise at the college level with the participation of all the guides of the project.

The CIE marks awarded for the Mini-project, shall be based on the evaluation of the project report, project presentation skill, and question and answer session in the ratio 50:25:25. The marks awarded for the project report shall be the same for all the batch mates.

No SEE component for Mini-Project.

However, they can opt for an elective offered by other Departments, provided they satisfy the prerequisite condition if any. Registration to open electives shall be documented under the guidance of the Program Coordinator/ Advisor/Mentor. The minimum number of students' strength for offering Open Elective Course is 10. However, this condition shall not be applicable to class where the admission to the program is less than 10.

Project Phase-I: Students have to discuss with the mentor /guide and with their helphe/she has to complete the literature survey and prepare the report and finally define the problem statement for the project work.
