For the benefit of stakeholders, the table below outlines the admission eligibility criteria for various undergraduate programs of VTU, based on the documents mentioned at the reference.

Sl.No	Programme	Academic Eligibility for admission to I Semester for the academic year 2026-27
1	B.E/B. Tech.,	Passed in 2nd PUC / 12th Std / Equivalent Exam with English as one of the Languages and obtained a Minimum of 45% of Marks in aggregate in Physics and Mathematics along with Chemistry / Bio-Technology / Biology / Electronics / Computer. (40% for SC, ST, Cat-1, 2A, 2B, 3A and 3B category candidates) OR A candidate who has passed any Diploma examination or equivalent examination and obtained an aggregate minimum of 45% marks taken together in all the subjects of the final year (Fifth and sixth semester) Diploma Examination (Q.E) is eligible for admission to B.E courses, and 40% of marks in Q. E. in case of SC, ST and Backward Classes of Karnataka candidates.
2	B. Plan.,	Passed 10+2 examination with mathematics obtained at least 45% marks in 10+2 (40% for SC, ST, Cat-1, 2A, 2B, 3A and 3B category candidates) shall be eligible for admission. Candidates who have not studied Mathematics at the 10+2 level shall complete additional bridge courses in Mathematics and Statistics during the first two semesters.[3][1] Along with the mathematics as one subject and remaining any two courses out of Physics/Chemistry/Computer Science/ Electronics/ Information Technology/ Biology/ Informatics Practices / biotechnology /Technical Vocational subject /Agriculture /Engineering Geographics /Business Studies /Entrepreneurship [3][4] OR Passed D.Voc stream in the same or allied sector(AICTE APH 2024-27 table 8.2 and 8.4 page 103-107) .[1][3]
3	B. Design	Admission to the first year of the course shall be open to the student; who have passed the two-year Pre-University Examination conducted by the Karnataka State Pre-University Board (PUC)/ C.B.S.E/ ISE/NIOS/ IGCSE/IB/ Board of other Indian States with any combination of subjects (such as conventional Arts/Commerce/Science) examination and obtained

- Any Public School/Board/University Examination in India or in foreign countries recognized by the UGC as equivalent to 10+2 system.
- Senior Secondary school Examination conducted by the National Open School with minimum five subjects.
- H.S.C. Vocational Examination
