- Sub:** Revised provision for conducting Make-up Examination (Supplementary Examination) for B.E./B.Tech. students admitted under the 2022 Scheme – reg

 [3] VTU/BGM/SA/Aca-Cirs/2024-25/2209 dated 13.08.2024 – Notification regarding Supplementary Examination (Makeup Examination) for affiliated college students admitted from 2022-23 onwards.
 [4]. Representations received from students/stakeholders regarding the conduct of Makeup Examination for earlier semester backlog courses.

With reference to the above, and in order to provide an additional opportunity to students admitted under the **2022 Scheme** to clear their backlog courses and facilitate their timely progression and completion of the B.E./B.Tech. programme, the existing provision for **Makeup Examination (Supplementary Examination)** is hereby revised as follows:

1. After the 6th Semester:

Makeup Examination shall be conducted for F-grade courses of all semesters from the 1st to the 6th Semester. This provision shall enable students having backlog courses in the 1st and 2nd Semesters to clear such courses after completion of the 6th Semester and become eligible for admission to the 7th Semester, subject to fulfilment of the prescribed eligibility conditions.

2. After the 8th Semester:

Makeup Examination shall be conducted for F-grade courses of all semesters from the 3rd to the 8th Semester, enabling students to clear their remaining backlog courses after completion of the programme duration.

3. The above revised provision shall be applicable to B.E./B.Tech. students admitted under the 2022 Scheme, of affiliated colleges, as per existing regulations and applicable notifications.
4. The Makeup Examination shall be conducted as per the schedule notified by the Registrar (Evaluation) from time to time.
5. This revised provision shall come into effect from the date of its notification and shall supersede the corresponding provisions relating to the scope of backlog courses contained in the earlier notification cited at Reference No. 3 above.
6. All other rules, regulations, eligibility conditions and examination procedures applicable to the 2022 Scheme shall remain unchanged.
7. This provision shall apply to all students who have taken readmission under the 2022 Scheme from an earlier scheme. If any of the failed/backlog courses belong to the previous scheme, such students shall be permitted to appear for and clear those backlog courses under the respective previous scheme only (If equivalence is not established).

The students admitted under the 2022 Scheme, including those who have been readmitted from a previous scheme, who have lost eligibility for admission to the 7th Semester in the academic year 2026-27 due to backlogs in the 1st and/or 2nd Semesters, may be permitted to appear for the respective backlog examinations.

As these students are required to appear for 2022 Scheme courses, including courses of the previous scheme in the case of students readmitted to the 2022 Scheme, the Registrar (Evaluation) may schedule an early Makeup

Examination to facilitate their admission to the 7th Semester, subject to their clearing the 1st and 2nd Semester backlogs.

The principals of all affiliated/constituent colleges are requested to bring the contents of this notification to the notice of all concerned students and ensure compliance.
